Objective of the Scholarship Policy

1. Merit-Based Scholarship for different courses

To reward scholastic excellence and motivate students to maintain high academic standards.

*Scholarship Continuation Policy

The scholarship may be continued from 2nd year onwards subject to:

- Minimum CGPA of **8.5 or above in previous academic year.**
- **No backlog** in any semester.

2. Need-Based/ Financial Assistance Scholarship

Provided to meritorious students from economically weaker section (**EWS**), weightage will be provided in accordance with Government norms and prescribed eligibility criteria:

3. Relaxation for candidates having exemplary achievements in Sports, Cultural & Arts

4. Relaxation for Children of Defence Personnel, Martyrs & All Girls

S. No.	Category	Merit Relaxation
1	Children of Defence Personnel, Martyrs	(a) Students who are dependents of serving or retired defence personnel, as well as children of martyrs who have laid down their lives in the line of duty, shall be eligible for an additional 5% relaxation in the admission merit criteria, based on the verified service category and case status. (b) The extent of the waiver shall be determined in accordance with the University's approved guidelines and upon submission of valid supporting documents issued by competent defence authorities.
2	All Girls Students	To promote and encourage girls' participation in higher education, an additional 5% relaxation shall be provided in the admission merit criteria.

5. Scholarships for wards of Alumnus of KIET

Students who are wards of Alumnus of KIET are eligible for an additional **10% relaxation** in the admission merit criteria or **10% fee waiver** in 1st year Fee.

6. Scholarships for siblings of currently enrolled students of KIET

Students who are siblings of currently enrolled students of KIET are eligible for an additional **5% relaxation** in the admission merit criteria or **5% fee waiver** in 1st year Fee.

7. Scholarships for wards of employee of KIET

Students who are wards of employees of KIET University are eligible for an additional **10% relaxation** in the admission merit criteria or a **5% fee waiver in each year** of study at KIET University.

Application & Approval Process

1. **Submission of Application:** Students shall submit the scholarship application at the time of admission through the prescribed online or offline mode.
2. **Document Verification:** All supporting documents shall be verified by the Admission Cell in coordination with the Scholarship Committee to authenticate eligibility.
3. **Committee Recommendation:** The Scholarship Committee shall evaluate applications based on defined eligibility criteria and the availability of scholarship quotas, and subsequently prepare its recommendations.
4. **Administrative Approval:** Final approval of the recommended candidates shall be granted jointly by the Director (Academics) and the Registrar.

Delegation of Authority

- (a) **Scholarship Committee:** Responsible for implementing the scholarship policy, reviewing applications, and verifying student eligibility.
- (b) **Director (Academics):** Provides final operational approval for scholarship awards and ensures compliance with academic regulations.
- (c) **Vice-Chancellor:** Holds the authority to approve amendments, revisions, or modifications to the scholarship policy.

Note:

1. Eligible students may avail only one type of fee-waiver scholarship at a time.
2. Failure to meet any of prescribed criteria may result in withdrawal of the scholarship.
3. All scholarship schemes are applicable at the time of admission only.
4. EWS seats are limited and will be offered on first cum first serve basis.
5. The percentage conversion from grade point will be applicable as per concerned university norms.
